- Commercial PACE The Kent County Levy Court approved a resolution to become our second participating county. I am working with the Kent County Administrator on final documentation. I have a meeting with the Sussex County Council on January 26th. I have at least three projects in Sussex County interested in C-PACE financing.
- **Board Retreat** We decided to hold off on our Board Retreat for two reasons. First, we want the focus of the retreat to be on strategic planning, but a key component will be the Delaware Climate Action Plan, which has not yet been published. Second, we would like to do the retreat in person as much as possible and want to wait until at least some of the pandemic restrictions are lifted. Staff attention has been directed toward our annual report. Once we have finalized the annual report, we will refocus on the strategic plan update.
- Clean Energy & Sustainability Accelerator I have previously reported on federal legislation to create the Clean Energy and Sustainability Accelerator that will fund a National Green Bank. The Green Bank Consortium is leading this effort. With the election of Joe Biden, and Senator Carper Chairing the Senate Energy and Public Works (EPW) Committee, this effort seems completely plausible. As the Delaware member of the Coalition, I have been asked to participate a meeting with Senator Carper's EPW staff next week.
